CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 8:04 a.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

OLD BUSINESS

Lou Ennesser requested FOIA #9 regarding Greenbrier Assisted Living Facility. Greenbrier requested an operating permit. However more information is needed before a permit is granted. They need a water report. The EPA needs a complete report of compliance by June 21. May 10th Greenbrier is planning their grand opening.

Block Party – Dee Monroe contacted Crown Water regarding a mascot suit. They said none was available. Hydro Water could supply an activity book, but does not have handouts. However they have a life size hydro available for audience photos, if we would like. We will print approximately 100 handouts.

Forum – Park District available date is December 2nd. They cannot confirm at this time. Lou Ennesser is working on dates, prices and availability at Gary Morava Park District and Golf Course. Obtaining speakers is a concern.

Meeting time change was not discussed.

Paul Fisher is working on a low voltage pump display. He has a small generator for a power source. We are not able to determine if there will be outlets available. He wants to carry the Prospect Heights Water Committee theme thru. Sean will contact Hersey graphic arts department. The Committee wants the Water Committee logo done in a professional manor.

NEW BUSINESS

Well Water Improvement Committee – Peter Falcone attended meetings concerning safe water. They are looking into testing. The Committee questions if residents are willing to test and send the information to the City. There was concern regarding the disposal of certain materials such as medicine, paint, oil, etc. If not disposed of correctly, will our wells eventually be contaminated? Paul Fisher said we can turn in drugs to the Police Department. Peter Falcone advised which items the City would take and dispose of.

The City will take fluorescent lights, medicine and drugs for disposal. The City needs to do a better job of advising residents.

Kay Michaely suggested that we educate our residents as to proper disposal of items and drugs.

Survey showed 51% of the residents like their wells.

Sean Dwyer read the petition to the Mayor and City Council regarding the Northwest Water Commission. We would like to receive the benefits of joining the NWWC . Peter Falcone advised that presently the Commission consist of 4 local municipalities and Cook County. They banded together and presently they sell water to Des Plaines. Des Plaines is a buyer not a member. Actions are done at the council level. They are meeting May 10th, 9 a.m., 1525 N. Wolf Road. Bob Korvas will meet with the Council and advise progress regarding our admittance. They may choose not to admit us.
