- Deputy Chief Caponigro said that he is in the final two weeks of Staff and Command. He noted that he is maintaining a 95 average in the classes. His graduation will be on January 14 at the Eagle Brook Country Club in Geneva.

- Chief Zawlocki noted that Officer Victor Castillo conducted his first DUI arrest.

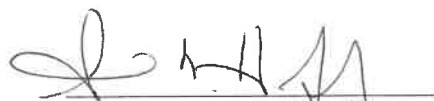
