DEPARTMENTAL UPDATES/CORRESPONDENCE – Chief Caponigro noted that Officer Tirovolas is on her own; and the other new officer and the lateral officer are on schedule to be on their own in two to three weeks.

- He noted that the Department has had several cases of officers sick with respiratory diseases.
- City Administrator Wade, Mayor Dolick, Alderman Cameron and the Police Chief met with Piper Lane residents to discuss the recent violence in that area. A faith-based organization is set to meet with the young people. There were 16 residents at the meeting. Chief Caponigro stated that the residents have been told, anything they see and report will be kept anonymous. He said that the Police have also been made aware of landlords forcing tenants to pay for bullet hole repair. He noted that the Police and Staff intervened on behalf of the tenant. He added that with increased police presence and the colder weather, the violent activities have subsided.
