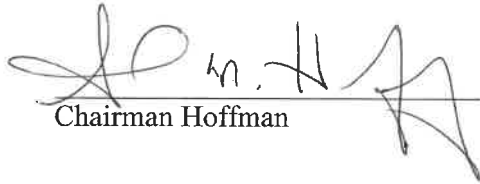
DEPARTMENTAL UPDATES/CORRESPONDENCE – None
