DEPARTMENTAL UPDATES/CORRESPONDENCE - Chief Derman updates that Officer Ryan Harth has been sworn in as a full-time officer after starting as a part-time officer. The Police Department was a recipient of the Lexipold gold level policy management award. This is a testament to keeping up to date with policy changes and making sure all the proper training is completed. Chief Derman is in contact with Northwest Central Dispatch about an online support system that would allow citizens to report 911 calls and crimes via an application. It is currently in the testing phase and Prospect Heights is weighing whether this would benefit the department. Saturday marked the end of the Cert Program

(Community Emergency Response). This training was put on by Cook County and spearheaded internally by Sergeant Deol and volunteer Marcia Jendreas. On March 2nd, the department took part in a polar plunge to support the Special Olympics. Upcoming on May 16th Cop on Rooftop event will be held at the Dunkin' Donuts on Milwaukee Ave to again help raise awareness of the Special Olympics.

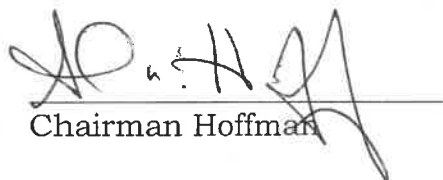
