DEPARTMENTAL UPDATES/CORRESPONDENCE – Chief Derman updates that Officer Colman is progressing well through the academy and is projected to return sometime in June. Officer Harth, who was a part-time officer and is now a full-time officer, is performing exceptionally well. There is an event coming up called "Cop on Top" where funds are raised for the Special Olympics. This event will take place from 5am-10am on Friday, May 16th. Chief Derman says both the Officers and Sergeants had their collective

bargaining agreements signed recently, so those are all good to go. Chief Derman also shouts out Commissioner Fiorito for participating in the IFPCA spring seminar, and completing the modules associated with it.

Commissioner Fiorito brings forth some of his findings from attending the IFPCA seminar. One area he brings up is Bill 1943, which is close to being passed. He also updates that the power test will be going away, and gives some reasoning for that not being required anymore. Commissioner Fiorito also discusses what the rule of 3 is in reference to the hiring process. He also talks about some training that is required of commissioners, including the open meetings act. There was some more discussion about the hiring process, specifically interview questions. Commissioner Fiorito also asks if there is a locked file of all commissioners' files, as this is the standard practice for a lot of other commissions.

NEXT MEETING –

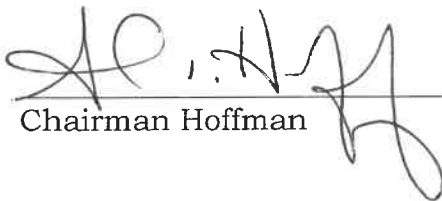
