**DEPARTMENTAL UPDATES/CORRESPONDENCE – Chief Derman** - Reported that the new eligibility list from the recent recruitment process has been distributed and that background investigations are underway, with the goal of preparing three candidates for the March Illinois State Police Academy. Candidates who pass backgrounds will move on to polygraph, psychological, medical, and physical evaluations and receive conditional offers before being sworn in. The department also announced that part-time officer Jacob Nashki will be sworn in on January 23; he brings prior experience with the Chicago Police Department, Chicago Fire Department, and Crystal Lake Park District Police.

Commissioners congratulated the department on recent accomplishments, including Officer of the Year recognition and positive citizen commendations, emphasizing the importance of acknowledging exemplary service.
