I. CALL TO ORDER

II. ROLL CALL

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

New prospective members are required to send a letter to the mayor to request the appointment and briefly explain why they should be appointed.

V. NEW BUSINESS

A. DISCUSS AND APPROVE SURVEY MAILING TO RESIDENTS WITHOUT CITY WATER

Discussion ensued regarding the water survey, its purpose and goals. Questions were approved by City Administrator, Joe Wade. Approximately 2300 single

family homes who do not have city water are targeted for this first survey. The purpose of the survey is to determine the interest and needs of these targeted areas for city water. Discussed the survey can be returned either via mail, email, fax or dropped off by the residents. Made clear that Water Committee is only an advisory committee and that if a group of residents in an area are interested in pursuing city water, the committee is there to support and advise them to form their own homeowners association to create their own SSA. Results of the survey should be able to be tabulated before the next meeting . Discussed printer to print surveys, obtaining addresses and related issues.

B. DISCUSS FOLLOW UP SURVEYS-

Discussed that there will be follow up surveys regarding water issues once we tabulate results of this current survey.

C. DISCUSS ELMHURST AND PALATINE RETIREMENT PROJECT -

Discussion ensued regarding the new retirement project on Elmhurst and Palatine Road and what they are doing regarding water. They do not have city water and before they spend a lot of money on digging wells it should be investigated as to whether they would be interested in pursuing city water.

Wendy Morgan-Adams made the motion. Ralph Kendall seconded the motion.
